



## Pope Francis' Message

Peace & all good to each & every one of you! ... [we] give thanks to the Father for all that he wished to reveal to one of the "little ones..." ... St. Francis of Assisi... son of a wealthy merchant... his encounter with Jesus led him to strip himself of an easy & carefree life in order to espouse "Lady Poverty" & to live as a true son of our heavenly Father. Francis radically imitated Christ: he clothed himself anew, putting on Christ, who though he was rich, became poor in order to make us rich by his poverty.... St. Francis: teach us to remain before the cross to let the crucified Christ gaze upon us to let ourselves be forgiven & be recreated by his love.... Being a Christian means having a living relationship with the person of Jesus; it means putting on Christ, being conformed to him... It began with the gaze of the crucified Jesus. With letting Jesus look at us at the very moment that he gives his life for us & draws us to himself... On the cross [of San Damiano], Jesus is depicted not as dead, but alive! Blood is flowing from his wounded hands, feet & side, but that blood speaks of life. Jesus' eyes aren't closed but open, wide open: he looks at us in a way that touches our hearts... The cross doesn't speak to us about defeat & failure... it speaks to us about a death which is life, a death which gives life for it speaks to us of love, the love of God incarnate, a love which doesn't die, but triumphs over evil & death....
