The fourth Sunday of the Easter Season is called the Good Shepherd Sunday. Jesus, in this discourse uses the pastoral metaphors about shepherd, hired hands, wolf and sheep. We can understand Jesus' discourse in the background of the story of the Healing of the man born blind (Jn. 9, 1-34) in which the Pharisees refuse to credit the miracle to Jesus. But the formerly blind man was blessed with the spiritual insight as well as with the physical sight and the religious leaders left with spiritual blindness. The refusal of affirming the miracle by the parents of the blind reflects them as the hired one who "sees the wolf coming, leaves the sheep and flees" (10, 12). Jesus reveals himself as the Good Shepherd who knows his flock and is sacrificed for them. Jesus expresses his immense

love and faithfulness toward the sheep that they may abide in his love.

La quarta Domenica del tempo pasquale è detta la domenica del Buon Pastore. Gesù con le sue parole usa le immagini del pastore, del mercenario, del lupo e delle pecore. Possiamo capire meglio il discorso di

Gesù se lo confrontiamo con il racconto della guarigione del cieco nato (Gv. 9, 1-34) quando i Farisei rifiutano di accettare il miracolo di Gesù. Mentre colui che era stato cieco riceve la grazia di vedere con lo spirito e con gli occhi, i capi religiosi restano nella loro cecità spirituale. La ritrosia a proclamare il miracolo da parte dei genitori del cieco li rende come il mercenario che "quando vede arrivare il lupo, lascia le pecore e fugge" (10, 12). Gesù si presenta come il Buon Pastore che conosce le sue pecore e che si è sacrificato per esse. Gesù mostra il suo smisurato amore ed il suo impegno per le sue pecore che possono rimanere nel suo amore.

El cuarto domingo de la temporada de Pascua se llama Domingo del Buen Pastor. Jesús, en este discurso utiliza las metáforas pastorales sobre el pastor, jornaleros, lobo y oveja. Podemos entender el discurso de Jesús en el trasfondo de la historia de la curación del ciego de nacimiento (Jn. 9, 1-34) en la que los Fariseos se niegan a atribuir el milagro a Jesús. Pero el que había sido ciego fue bendecido con la percepción espiritual así como con la vista física y los líderes religiosos quedaron con ceguera espiritual. La negativa de los padres de los ciegos a afirmar el milagro los refleja como el asalariado que "ve venir al lobo, deja las ovejas y huye" (10, 12). Jesús se revela como el Buen Pastor que conoce a su rebaño y es sacrificado por ellos. Jesús expresa su inmenso amor y fidelidad hacia las ovejas para que permanezcan en su amor.

Pope Francis' Message

On this Third Sunday of Easter, the two disciples of Emmaus had listened... to Jesus... recognized him "in the breaking of the bread." ...the Risen Christ... greets the group of disciples: "Peace to you!" But they are frightened... "that they saw a spirit..." Jesus shows them the wounds in his body and says: "See my hands and my feet... that it is I; handle me." And to convince them, he asks for food and eats it before them... the Apostles "still disbelieved for joy." The joy they had was such that they could not believe that this was true. And a second detail: they were bewildered, astonished... because the encounter with God always leads you to astonishment: it goes beyond enthusiasm, beyond joy; it is another experience... that made them think: no, this cannot be true! It is the astonishment of God's presence... Three very concrete verbs characterize this Gospel passage. In a certain sense, they reflect our individual and community life: *to look, to touch and to eat*. Three actions that can give joy from a true encounter with the living Jesus. To look. "See my hands and my feet," Jesus says. *To look* is not only to see; ...it also involves intention, will. For this reason, it is one of the verbs of love. ...*Looking* is a first step against indifference, against the temptation to look the other way before the difficulties and sufferings of others. To look. *Do I see or look at* Jesus? The second verb is *to touch*. By inviting the disciples to touch him, to verify that he is not a ghost... Jesus indicates to them and to us that the relationship with Him and with our brothers and sisters cannot remain "at a distance." Christianity does not exist at a distance... Love requires looking and it also requires closeness; it requires contact, the sharing of life. The Good Samaritan did not limit himself to looking at that man whom he found half dead along the road: he stopped, he bent down, he treated his wounds, he touched him, he loaded him on his mount and took him to the inn. And it is the same with Jesus: loving him means entering into a communion of life... with Him. And thus, we come to the third verb, *to eat*, which clearly expresses our humanity in its most natural poverty, our need to nourish ourselves in order to live... also becomes an expression of love, an expression of communion, of celebration... Eating together the Body of Christ: this is the core of Christian life. ...Jesus draws near to us he fills us with joy, to the point of disbelief, and he leaves us bewildered, with that astonishment that only God's presence gives, because Jesus is a living Person. Being Christian is ...a living relationship with Him, with the Risen Lord: we look at him, we touch him, we are nourished by Him and, transformed by his Love, we look at, touch and nourish others as brothers and sisters. May the Virgin Mary help us to live this experience of grace. ...Please do not forget to pray for me....
