The Risen Lord meets two of his disciples on their way to Emmaus, a village seven miles far from Jerusalem. This Resurrection narrative explains the Compassion of Our Savior towards his disciples. i. Jesus comes forward and joins with them in their conversation as a stranger, ii. Jesus inquires about their sorrow with compassion, iii. Jesus listens to their Narration about the Passion of their Teacher and Prophet with empathy, iv. Jesus explains about the Christ Event that is His Passion, Death and Resurrection as the fulfillment of the Old

Testament Prophecy. However, they were unable to understand His word; v. Finally, Jesus manifests Himself to them through the Breaking of the Bread. Even today, the Risen Lord communicates to us His Compassion in various ways. Finally, through the Holy Eucharist which is the basis of our Christian living. Whenever we participate in this Holy Sacrament, the Risen Lord opens our eyes, minds and hearts to understand him better through the breaking of His Word and the breaking His Body that we may love Him and our neighbors.

Infine, Gesù si manifesta loro attraverso lo spezzare il pane. Anche oggi il Risorto ci comunica in vari modi la sua compassione. Infine, attraverso la Santa Eucaristia che è la base della nostra vita cristiana. Ogni volta che partecipiamo a questo Santissimo Sacramento, il Signore Risorto apre i nostri occhi, la mente e il cuore per comprenderlo meglio attraverso la rottura della Sua Parola e la rottura del Suo Corpo affinché possiamo amare Lui e il nostro prossimo.

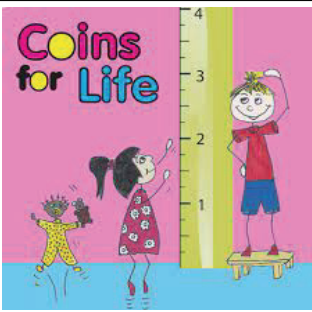
