**Third Sunday of Lent, March 3, 2024**

The episode of the expulsion of the merchants in the temple was so forcefully imprinted in the disciples' memories that it was reported in all the Gospels. What is surprising and moving about Jesus is seeing how the tenderness of a woman in love and the courage of a hero coexist and alternate in him, as in a dance step, with all the passion and impetuosity of the Middle East. Jesus enters the temple: and it is like entering the center of time and space. In the temple he finds the animal sellers: sheep, oxen and merchants are chased out, all together, eloquence of gestures. Instead he speaks to the dove sellers: the dove was the offering of the poor, there is a sort of respect towards them. He threw money to the ground, the God of money, the mammon idol raised above all, installed in the temple like a king on the throne, the eternal golden calf. Do not make my Father's house a market... I wonder what the true house of the father is. A house of stones? "We are the house of God if we cherish freedom and hope" (Heb 3:6).

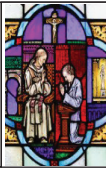


L'episodio della cacciata dei mercanti nel tempio si è stampato così prepotentemente nella memoria dei discepoli da essere riportato da tutti i Vangeli. Ciò che sorprende, e commuove, in Gesù è vedere come in lui convivono e si alternano, come in un passo di danza, la tenerezza di una donna innamorata e il coraggio di un eroe, con tutta la passione e l'irruenza del mediorientale. Gesù entra nel tempio: ed è come entrare nel centro del tempo e dello spazio. Nel tempio trova i venditori di animali: pecore, buoi e mercanti sono cacciati fuori, tutti insieme, eloquenza dei gesti. Invece ai venditori di colombe rivolge la parola: la colomba era l'offerta dei poveri, c'è come un riguardo verso di loro. Gettò a terra il denaro, il Dio denaro, l'idolo mammona innalzato su tutto, insediato nel tempio come un re sul trono, l'eterno vitello d'oro. Non fate della casa del Padre mio un mercato... Mi domando qual è la vera casa del padre. Una casa di pietre? «Casa di Dio siamo noi se custodiamo libertà e speranza» (Eb 3,6).





El episodio de la expulsión de los mercaderes del templo quedó tan fuertemente grabado en la memoria de los discípulos que fue relatado en todos los Evangelios. Lo sorprendente y conmovedor de Jesús es ver cómo la ternura de una mujer enamorada y el coraje de un héroe conviven y se alternan en él, como en un paso de danza, con toda la pasión y la impetuosidad de Oriente Medio. Jesús entra al templo: y es como entrar en el centro del tiempo y del espacio. En el templo encuentra a los vendedores de animales: ovejas, bueyes y mercaderes son expulsados, todos juntos, elocuencia de gestos. En cambio, les habla a los vendedores de palomas: la paloma era la ofrenda de los pobres, hay una especie de respeto hacia ellos. Arrojó al suelo el dinero, el Dios del dinero, el ídolo de Mammon elevado sobre todo, instalado en el templo como un rey en el trono, el eterno becerro de oro. No hagáis de la casa de mi Padre un mercado... Me pregunto cuál será la verdadera casa del padre. ¿Una casa de piedras? "Somos casa de Dios si apreciamos la libertad y la esperanza" (Heb 3,6).

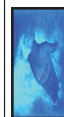
