- Weekly Reflection -

Why do you follow Jesus?

Jesus, through the question, "Who do people say I am?" strives to uncover why his disciples follow him. Their responses show that they see him like any other prophet, like John the Baptist or Elijah. But St. Peter confesses that Jesus is the Messiah. Yet later when Jesus shares his destiny of great suffering and death, it is then that St Peter and the other disciples have a 'fit' since it goes against their understanding of the Messiah, who would come to liberate Israel in triumphant glory with his army! Their minds were set on human things and not divine. Do we know how we would like Jesus as the Messiah to come and function in our lives?

¿Por qué le sigues a Jesús?

A través de la pregunta «¿Quién dice la gente que soy yo?», Jesús intenta descubrir por qué le siguen sus discípulos. Sus respuestas muestran que le ven como a cualquier otro profeta, como Juan el Bautista o Elías. Pero San Pedro confiesa que Jesús es el Mesías. Sin embargo, más tarde, cuando Jesús comparte su destino de gran sufrimiento y muerte, San Pedro y los otros discípulos hacen un «berrinche», ya que va en contra de lo que piensan del Mesías, ¡que vendría a liberar a Israel en gloria triunfante con su ejército! Sus mentes estaban puestas en cosas humanas y no en las divinas. ¿Sabemos cómo nos gustaría que Jesús, el Mesías, viniera y actuara en nuestras vidas?

Perché seguite Gesù?

Attraverso la domanda "Chi dice la gente che io sia?", Gesù cerca di scoprire perché i suoi discepoli lo seguono. Le loro risposte mostrano che lo vedono come un qualsiasi altro profeta, come Giovanni Battista o Elia. Ma San Pietro confessa che Gesù è il Messia. Più tardi, però, quando Gesù condivide il suo destino di grande sofferenza e morte, San Pietro e gli altri discepoli fanno i "capricci" perché ciò va contro quello che pensano del Messia, che sarebbe venuto a liberare Israele nella gloria trionfale con il suo esercito! La loro mente era fissata su cose umane e non su cose divine. Sappiamo come vorremmo che Gesù, il Messia, venisse e agisse nella nostra vita?
