The Root of the Problem

The problem is taken to its root: no longer repudiation or not, but keeping alive the breath of origin, committing with all strength to nurture God's dream: protecting and guarding gestures, thoughts, words that in turn have the joyful power to protect love and unite lives, because love is fragile and hungry for care. True sin is not transgressing a norm, but God's dream. And this happens upstream, it is a long thin web that is slowly woven with those harsh or indifferent behaviors that extinguish love: unfaithfulness, disrespect, offense to dignity, being on each other cause of daily mortification instead of life.

La raíz del problema

El problema es llevado a su raíz: ya no repudiar o no, sino mantener vivo el aliento del origen, comprometerse con todas las fuerzas a alimentar el sueño de Dios: proteger y custodiar gestos, pensamientos, palabras que tengan a su vez la fuerza gozosa de proteger el amor y unir las vidas, porque el amor es frágil y está hambriento de cuidados. El verdadero pecado no es transgredir una norma, sino el sueño de Dios. Y esto sucede río arriba, es una larga y delgada telaraña que se teje lentamente con esos comportamientos duros o indiferentes que apagan el amor: la infidelidad, la falta de respeto, la ofensa a la dignidad, el estar uno encima del otro provocando mortificación cotidiana en lugar de vida.

Il problema è portato alla radice: non più ripudio o no, ma tener vivo il respiro dell'origine, impegnarsi con tutte le forze ad alimentare il sogno di Dio: proteggere e custodire gesti, pensieri, parole che hanno a loro volta la gioiosa forza di proteggere l'amore e congiungere le vite, perché l'amore è fragile e affamato di cure. Vero peccato non è trasgredire una norma, ma il sogno di Dio. E questo accade a monte, è una lunga tela sottile che si tesse lentamente con quei comportamenti duri o indifferenti che spengono l'amore: infedeltà, mancanza di rispetto, offesa alla dignità, essere l'uno sull'altro causa di mortificazione quotidiana, anziché di vita.
