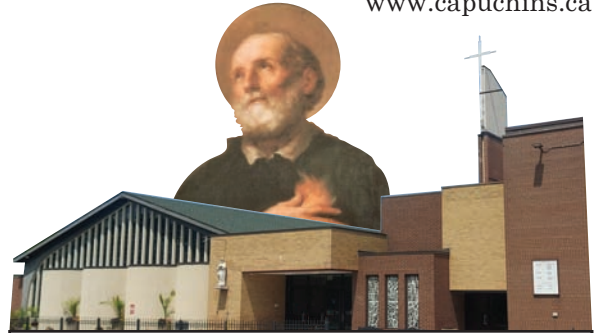

- Weekly Reflection -
Jesus Accomplishment of the Father's Will

Jesus puts it very succinctly to James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who are in the group of his closest disciples, that their enthusiasm to be at both sides of Jesus in heaven needs to be seen from the lens of the will of God, the Father, who decides everything. God willed to send His Son into the world to save the world and restore the strained relationship of humanity with God. Jesus accomplished this by obeying and serving the will of the Father as a servant who suffered. Jesus willingly accepted the will of the Father, and he came into the world to serve the people of God through His life. Jesus willingly offered His life as a ransom for the sins of the people of God to rescue them from their bondage to sin. Likewise, Christians are called to emulate Jesus not by seeking self-glory and lording over another, but instead by serving one another because in serving each other we are in turn serving Jesus and the Father.

All Saints Day Mass

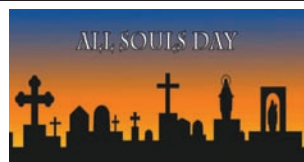


Masses for the solemnity of All Saints on Friday, November 1st, 2024, will be as follows:
