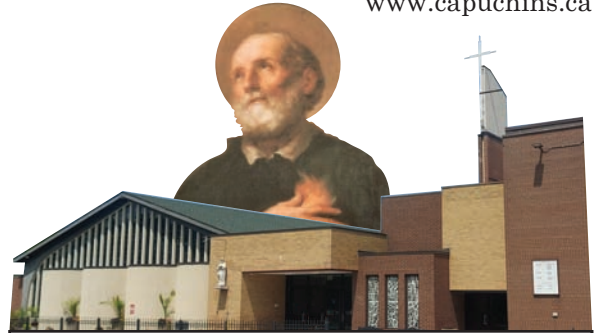

Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Friday Mass



Every first Friday of the month the well-known Sacred Heart devotions take place. This devotion was requested by Our Lord Himself in the revelations He made regarding His Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a nun of the Visitation Order who lived in France in the 17th century. The particular intention of the First Friday devotions is to offer reparation for the innumerable offenses committed against the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The requirements for fulfilling the devotion and obtaining the promise are to receive Holy Communion on the first Friday of nine consecutive months, as Our Lord instructed, and to have the intention of making reparation to the Sacred Heart.

As usual, our parish will have the first Friday devotion which includes a trilingual mass at 7pm on Friday November 1st, 2024. Afterwards, there will be a guided meditation with the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Our Lord will remain exposed all throughout the night.
