

Pope Francis Releases Encyclical on the Sacred Heart of Jesus

In his latest encyclical, Dilexit Nos (Latin for "He Loves Us"), Pope Francis dedicates this pastoral letter to the human and divine love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. As the Holy Father writes, "His open heart has gone before us and waits for us, unconditionally, asking only to offer us His love and friendship."

In the encyclical, the fourth of Pope Francis' papacy, he also speaks of the world "losing its heart" due to wars, socio-economic disparities and the uses of technology that threaten our humanity."

Dilexit Nos was released to coincide with the 350th anniversary of St. Margaret Mary Alocoque's first apparition, which helped inspire enhanced devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Message for All Souls Day from Archbishop Leo

"Praying for the deceased should never be seen as something morbid, or as a failure to "move on" with our own life from the death of a loved one. When we pray for those who have passed away before us,

we contemplate the mystery of the Death and Resurrection of Christ; we acknowledge with personal and ecclesial faith that for Christ's faithful "life is changed not ended, and, when this earthly dwelling turns to dust, an eternal dwelling is made ready for them in heaven" (Preface I For the Dead, The Roman Missal, 2011); and finally, as members of the communion of saints, we petition the Lord for mercy and forgiveness on behalf of those who have died in the peace of Christ...."
