

- Weely Reflection Jesus' Mission

In the account of Jesus' address to the people of his town of Nazareth, the evangelist places the prologue of the Gospel before it; he intends to be a historian because he wants Christians to realize "the soundness of the teachings" they have received and to be convinced of the decisive importance for the history of all people of Jesus' life. For this reason, only Luke places the beginning of Jesus' public ministry narrative as programmatic discourse that immediately specifies the purpose Jesus sets for himself. It is Jesus' "manifesto." He works by the power of God; in fact, the Spirit is upon him. His will not be a human work, least of all political, but the revelation of God's plan. His mission is to mercifully welcome all people to set them free. It is the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy that Jesus appropriates.

La misión de Jesús

En el relato del discurso de Jesús a la gente de su pueblo de Nazaret, el evangelista antepone el prólogo del Evangelio; pretende ser historiador porque quiere que los cristianos se den cuenta de «la solidez de las enseñanzas» que han recibido y se convenzan de la importancia decisiva para la historia de todos los hombres de la vida de Jesús. Por esta razón, sólo Lucas sitúa el comienzo de la narración del ministerio público de Jesús como un discurso programático que especifica inmediatamente el propósito que Jesús se fija. Es el «manifiesto» de Jesús. Él obra por el poder de Dios; de hecho, el Espíritu está sobre él. La suya no será una obra humana, y menos política, sino la revelación del plan de Dios. Su misión es acoger misericordiosamente a todos los hombres para liberarlos. Es el cumplimiento de la profecía de Isaías de la que Jesús se apropia.
