Consecrated to God

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. As per Jewish tradition, the first-born male child was to be presented and consecrated to God in the Temple. Just as the first fruits of the harvest from the earth were offered to God, so also the first fruits of the womb were offered to God. The presentation of the first-born child to God symbolised that the child would be consecrated to God for his service. At a deeper level, the presentation of Jesus signified that the entire life of Jesus was dedicated and consecrated to God to accomplish God's will and plan of salvation. Similarly, we are called to present and dedicate our lives to God to participate, in, with and through Christ, in accomplishing God's will and plan of salvation here on earth. We pray for all those who present and dedicate themselves to God as priests, religious, and consecrated persons; they make a lifelong commitment to Jesus by offering their lives in service of others.

Rezamos por todos los que se presentan y dedican a Dios como sacerdotes, religiosos y personas consagradas; ellos se comprometen de por vida con Jesús ofreciendo su vida al servicio de los demás.

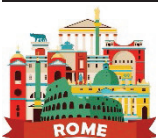
