#### - Weekly Reflection -

#### First Sunday of Lent

Lent begins with a reflection on the temptation of Jesus in the desert. We begin Lent with this story of temptations. We all have experiences of temptations. We need to face and overcome temptations as Jesus did, using the means He employed: We are tempted to sinful pleasures, easy riches, and power, and sometimes we are drawn to use unjust or sinful means to achieve those ends. Jesus is our model for overcoming temptations through prayer, penance, and the effective use of the "Word of God" in the Scriptures.
