

What Is The Jubilee?



In the year of Our Lord 1300, Pope Boniface VIII called for the first Jubilee. A Jubilee year is intended to be a special and holy year, marked as a time to re-establish a proper relationship with God and with one another. Initially celebrated every 100 years, in 13 43 Pope Clement VI reduced the gap to 50 years before Pope Paul II reduced it further in 1470 to every 25 years.

What is an indulgence?

An Indulgence is the remission of temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven. Indulgences can be partial or plenary depending on whether part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin has been remitted. Indulgences truly are an outpouring of God's abundant grace and mercy.

What is a Jubilee Indulgence?

The Jubilee Indulgence is a plenary indulgence which thanks to the power of prayer, is intended in a particular way for those who have gone before us, so that they may obtain full mercy. It may also be sought for oneself.

How is the Jubilee Indulgence Obtained?

One who is truly repentant and free from any attachment to or desire for sin, moved by a spirit of charity, must to the following to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence: go to Confession; receive Holy Communion; and pray for the intentions of the Pope. The Jubilee Indulgence may be applied to the souls of Purgatory, which is a most commendable act of mercy.
