Third Sunday of Easter


The third time that Jesus manifests himself to his followers, after the resurrection, is full of events and teachings. He stops on the shore of the lake to cook fish for them, and to present himself again as one who serves, because the Risen One is all Love, lifegiving Spirit. And it is on love that he questions Peter. That human dialogue between Jesus and Peter tells all of us something extremely consoling. It tells us that, if we err, Jesus, once we have repented, does not remember our mistake and sees in us only that splendid plan for which God created us. This is the mercy of God!
