The title "Shepherd" means one who guides, feeds, nourishes, comforts, corrects, and protects his flock—responsibilities that belong to all Church leaders, parents, civic leaders, and all those in charge of others. ### Seeing with Heart: A Day of Reflection



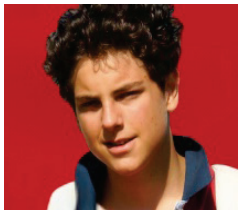
