## Weekly Reflection

### Fifth Sunday of Easter

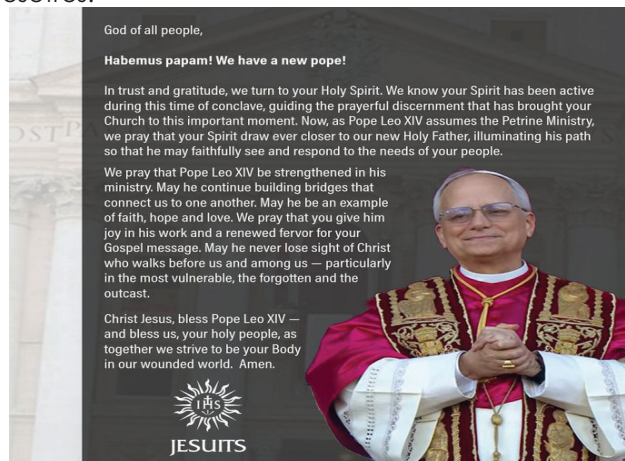
We are back in the context of the Last Supper, and Jesus, after explaining to the disciples that one of them will betray him, instead of asking the disciples to bring Judas to stop him, take revenge or simply defend themselves, as I would have rightly done, Jesus, who has a different criterion of justice than mine, helps him to leave the Sanhedrin freely, thus showing us that he is willing to be killed even for Judas. He does it because he loves him. For Jesus, not being able to make Judas understand and accept his proposal of a new man is an experience of great failure and suffering, but this does not stop him from continuing to love him. This is what shows that his capacity to love is glorious, because it is weighty, substantial. This is what gives me the certainty that Jesus is able to love me and all of us.

### Quinta domenica di Pasqua

Siamo tornati nel contesto dell'ultima cena, e Gesù, dopo aver spiegato ai discepoli che uno di loro lo tradirà, invece di chiedere ai discepoli di menare Giuda per fermarlo, vendicarsi o semplicemente difendersi, come giustamente avrei fatto io, Gesù, che ha un criterio di giustizia diverso dal mio, lo aiuta ad uscire liberamente dal Sinedrio, dimostrandoci così che è disposto a farsi uccidere anche per Giuda. Lo fa perché lo ama. Per Gesù, il non essere riuscito a fare capire e accettare la sua proposta di uomo nuovo a Giuda è un'esperienza di grande fallimento e di sofferenza, ma questo non gli impedisce di continuare ad amarlo. Questo è ciò che dimostra che la sua capacità di amare è gloriosa, perché di peso, sostanzioso. Questo è ciò che mi dà la sicurezza che Gesù è in grado di amare anche me e tutti noi.

### Quinto domingo de Pascua

Estamos de nuevo en el contexto de la Última Cena, y Jesús, después de haber explicado a los discípulos que uno de ellos le traicionará, en lugar de pedir a los discípulos que traigan a Judas para detenerle, vengarse o simplemente defenderse, como yo habría hecho correctamente, Jesús, que tiene un criterio de justicia diferente al mío, le ayuda a salir libremente del Sanedrín, mostrándonos así que está dispuesto a ser asesinado incluso por Judas. Lo hace porque le encanta. Para Jesús, no conseguir que Judas comprenda y acepte su propuesta de un hombre nuevo es una experiencia de gran fracaso y sufrimiento, pero esto no le impide seguir amándolo. Esto es lo que prueba que su capacidad de amar es gloriosa, porque es de peso, sustancial. Esto es lo que me da la confianza de que Jesús es capaz de amarme a mí y a todos nosotros.

### Horizons of Hope



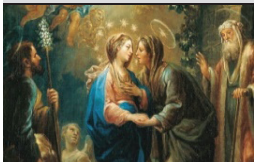

### Seeing with Heart: A Day of Reflection



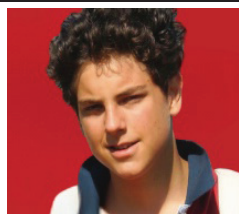

### Eucharistic Miracles for World Exhibit at St. Philip Neri Church



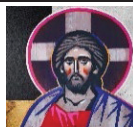
