The Most Holy Trinity

Weekly Reflection

The full revelation of God as **Father, Son and Holy Spirit** occurs in the mystery of Easter, when Jesus gives his life for the love of his disciples. It was necessary that they first experience the supreme gift of love accomplished by Jesus in order to understand the reality of God as Love who gives all of himself. In addition to forgiving sins and reconciling man with himself, he calls him to a communion full of life ("On that day you will know that I am in the Father and you in me and I in you"). He reveals to man the richness of his gifts and the hope of future glory and calls him to a life of holiness and giving in love for his neighbor, "This is my commandment: that you love one another as I have loved you". They too, following the example of their master, are called to give their lives for the Brothers, "No one has greater love than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends". For now they are incapable of welcoming and accepting such realities. The Holy Spirit will make the love of Christ crucified and resurrected for them enter into the hearts of the apostles.

La piena rivelazione di Dio come **Padre, Figlio e Spirito Santo** si ha nel mistero della Pasqua, quando Gesù dona la vita per amore dei suoi discepoli. Bisognava che questi sperimentassero innanzitutto il supremo dono dell'amore compiuto da Gesù per comprendere la realtà di Dio Amore che dona tutto se stesso. Egli, oltre a perdonare i peccati e a riconciliare l'uomo con sé, lo chiama ad una comunione piena di vita ("In quel giorno voi saprete che io sono nel Padre e voi in me ed io in voi"). Rivela all'uomo la ricchezza dei suoi doni e della speranza della gloria futura e lo chiama ad una vita di santità e di donazione nell'amore al prossimo, "Questo è il mio comandamento: che vi amiate gli uni gli altri come io vi ho amati". Anch'essi sull'esempio del loro maestro sono chiamati a dare la vita per i Fratelli, "Nessuno ha un amore più grande di questo: dare la vita per i propri amici". Per ora essi sono incapaci di accogliere e accettare tali realtà. Lo Spirito Santo farà entrare nel cuore degli apostoli l'amore di Cristo crocifisso e risuscitato per loro.

La plena revelación de Dios como **Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo** ocurre en el misterio de la Pascua, cuando Jesús entrega su vida por amor a sus discípulos. Era necesario que experimentaran primero el don supremo de amor realizado por Jesús para comprender la realidad de Dios como Amor que se entrega por completo. Además de perdonar los pecados y reconciliar al hombre consigo mismo, lo llama a una comunión llena de vida ("En aquel día conoceréis que yo estoy en el Padre y vosotros en mí y yo en vosotros"). Revela al hombre la riqueza de sus dones y la esperanza de la gloria futura y lo llama a una vida de santidad y entrega en amor al prójimo: "Este es mi mandamiento: que os améis los unos a los otros como yo os he amado". También ellos, siguiendo el ejemplo de su maestro, están llamados a dar la vida por los Hermanos: "Nadie tiene amor más grande que este: dar la vida por sus amigos". Por ahora son incapaces de acoger y aceptar tales realidades. El Espíritu Santo hará entrar en el corazón de los apóstoles el amor de Cristo crucificado y resucitado por ellos

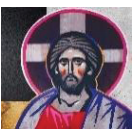
