Weekly Reflection

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

"He who humbles himself will be exalted." To become humble, one must begin to love. That's what Jesus did. Merciful love brought him down from heaven. Love drove him onto the streets of Palestine. Love led him to seek out the sick, the sinners, the suffering. The same love led him, without delay, to his goal, Calvary, where "he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross" (Phil 2:8). Humility was the outward form of his divine charity and his external accompanier. Humility was an attitude proper to the holy Mother who, because of her purity, was pleasing to God and, because of her humility, drew God to herself, because God "resists the proud; but to the humble he gives his grace" (Jas 4:6). Mary was humble because she loved the will of God and of the people around her.

22do Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

"El que se humilla será exaltado". Para llegar a ser humilde, uno debe comenzar a amar. Eso es lo que hizo Jesús. El amor misericordioso lo hizo bajar del cielo. El amor lo llevó a las calles de Palestina. El amor lo llevó a buscar a los enfermos, a los pecadores, a los que sufren. El mismo amor lo llevó, sin demora, a su meta, el Calvario, donde «se humilló a sí mismo y se hizo obediente hasta la muerte, y muerte de cruz» (Flp 2, 8). La humildad era la forma externa de su caridad divina y su acompañante externo. La humildad era una actitud propia de la santa Madre que, por su pureza, agradaba a Dios y, por su humildad, atraía a Dios hacia sí, porque Dios "resiste a los soberbios; pero a los humildes les da su gracia" (Stg 4:6). María era humilde porque amaba la voluntad de Dios y de las personas que la rodeaban.

22ma Domenica del Tempo Ordinario

"Chi si umilia sarà esaltato". Per diventare umili, bisogna cominciare ad amare. Questo è ciò che Gesù ha fatto. L'amore misericordioso lo fece scendere dal cielo. L'amore lo ha spinto per le strade della Palestina. L'amore lo ha portato a cercare i malati, i peccatori, i sofferenti. Lo stesso amore lo condusse, senza indugio, alla sua meta, il Calvario, dove «umiliò se stesso facendosi obbediente fino alla morte e alla morte di croce» (Fil 2,8). L'umiltà era la forma esteriore della sua carità divina e del suo accompagnatore esterno. L'umiltà era un atteggiamento proprio della santa Madre che, per la sua purezza, era gradita a Dio e, per la sua umiltà, attirava Dio a sé, perché Dio "resiste ai superbi; ma agli umili dà la sua grazia» (Gc 4,6). Maria era umile perché amava la volontà di Dio e delle persone che la circondavano.

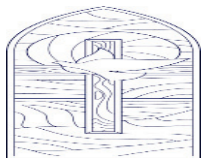
