"Whoever comes to me and does not hate their father and mother; spouse and children, brothers and sisters, yes and even life itself cannot be my disciple." 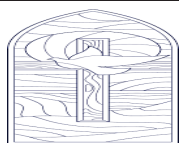
23er Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
