The Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Weekly Reflection

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Saint Helen found the True Cross in Jerusalem in 326 AD, and her son, Emperor Constantine, dedicated the Church of the Holy Sepulchre on September 14, 335 AD where the relic was presented and publicly exalted or lifted up to be venerated; this tradition continues till today. Christ's cross is celebrated as a sign of Christ's victory over sin and death. When He offered His life on the Cross, Christ obtained salvation for humanity. The Cross is an instrument of God's saving love and is a source of strength in trials, a sign of hope in despair, and a reminder that we belong to Christ. God commanded Moses to place a bronze serpent on a pole so the Israelites by looking at it would be saved from snake bites. Christians look to Christ, on the Cross, as our Saviour and Redeemer.

Questa domenica celebriamo la festa dell'Esaltazione della Santa Croce. Sant'Elena trovò la Vera Croce a Gerusalemme nel 326 d.C., e suo figlio, l'imperatore Costantino, dedicò la Chiesa del Santo Sepolcro il 14 settembre del 335 d.C. dove la reliquia fu presentata e pubblicamente esaltata o innalzata per essere venerata; Questa tradizione continua ancora oggi. La croce di Cristo è celebrata come segno della vittoria di Cristo sul peccato e sulla morte. Quando ha offerto la sua vita sulla croce, Cristo ha ottenuto la salvezza per l'umanità. La Croce è uno strumento dell'amore salvifico di Dio ed è fonte di forza nelle prove, un segno di speranza nella disperazione e un promemoria che apparteniamo a Cristo. Dio comandò a Mosè di mettere un serpente di bronzo su un'asta in modo che gli Israeliti, guardandolo, fossero salvati dai morsi dei serpenti. I cristiani guardano a Cristo, sulla Croce, come al nostro Salvatore e Redentore.

Este domingo celebramos la fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz. Santa Elena encontró la Vera Cruz en Jerusalén en el año 326 d.C., y su hijo, el emperador Constantino, dedicó la Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro el 14 de septiembre del año 335 d.C., donde la reliquia fue presentada y exaltada públicamente o levantada para su veneración; Esta tradición continúa hoy. La cruz de Cristo se celebra como un signo de la victoria de Cristo sobre el pecado y la muerte. Cuando Cristo ofreció su vida en la cruz, obtuvo la salvación para la humanidad. La cruz es un instrumento del amor salvador de Dios y es una fuente de fortaleza en las pruebas, un signo de esperanza en la desesperación y un recordatorio de que pertenecemos a Cristo. Dios le ordenó a Moisés que colocara una serpiente de bronce en una asta para que los israelitas se salvaran de las mordeduras de serpientes al mirarla. Los cristianos miran a Cristo, en la Cruz, como a nuestro Salvador y Redentor.
