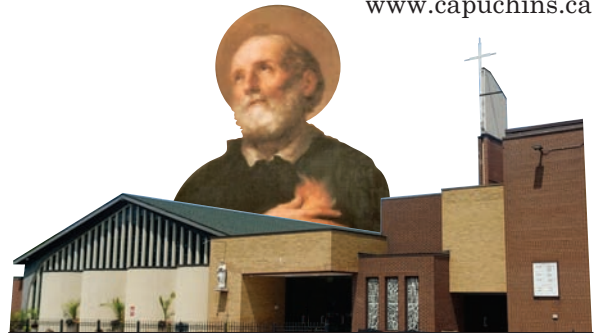

Faith is a relationship with a person, a personal intimate relationship with Jesus, a being with Him. It is an active act of trust, of abandonment in the Lord. If we trust in Him, we can try to live love as He lived it, giving our life so that others may have life in abundance. But to live a relationship, we must cultivate it, find a way to be with Him, not only for an hour a week laboriously trying to go to Mass on Sunday, but to live our days with Him. How can we do this? The Word He left us is the only way... Read the Gospel every day, meditate on it, assimilate it, let ourselves be challenged by the provocations of Scripture, compare our decisions with this infinite horizon...Perhaps, even use the tools that so many of us use at different times of the day: smartphones, for example, tablets...Why not save the Gospel of the day (perhaps with a helpful commentary) on these devices so that when we pick them up to respond, to view the news, to navigate, the Gospel also comes to the forefront?

La fede è una relazione con una persona, una relazione personale intima con Gesù, un essere con Lui. È un atto di fiducia, di abbandono nel Signore. Se confidiamo in Lui, possiamo provare a vivere l'amore come lo ha vissuto Lui, donando la nostra vita affinché gli altri possano avere vita in abbondanza. Ma per vivere una relazione, dobbiamo coltivarla, trovare un modo per stare con Lui, non solo per un'ora alla settimana cercando faticosamente di andare a Messa la domenica, ma per vivere le nostre giornate con Lui. ¿Come possiamo farlo? La Parola che ci ha lasciato è l'unica via... Leggere il Vangelo ogni giorno, meditarlo, assimilarlo, lasciarsi interpellare dalle provocazioni della Scrittura, confrontare le nostre decisioni con questo orizzonte infinito... Magari anche usando gli strumenti che tanti di noi usano in diversi momenti della giornata: smartphone, ad esempio, tablet... Perché non salvare il Vangelo del giorno (magari con un commento utile) su questi dispositivi in modo che quando li prendiamo per rispondere, per leggere le notizie, per navigare, anche il Vangelo venga in primo piano?

La fe es una relación con una persona, una relación personal íntima con Jesús, un estar con Él. Es un acto de confianza, de abandono en el Señor. Si confiamos en Él, podemos tratar de vivir el amor como Él lo vivió, dando nuestra vida para que otros puedan tener vida en abundancia. Pero para vivir una relación, debemos cultivarla, encontrar una manera de estar con Él, no solo durante una hora a la semana tratando laboriosamente de ir a Misa el domingo, sino de vivir nuestros días con Él. ¿Cómo podemos hacer esto? La Palabra que nos dejó es el único camino... Leer el Evangelio todos los días, meditarlo, asimilarlo, dejarse interpellar por los desafíos de la Escritura, comparar nuestras decisiones con este horizonte infinito... Quizás, incluso usando los dispositivos que muchos de nosotros utilizamos en diferentes momentos del día: smartphones, por ejemplo, tabletas... ¿Por qué no guardar el Evangelio del día (tal vez con un comentario útil) en estos dispositivos para que cuando los recojamos para responder, para ver las noticias, para navegar, el Evangelio también pase a primer plano?
