Weekly Reflection

The singular theme from this Sunday's readings is giving thanks or having gratitude to God and to others. In the first reading, we see Naaman, an Aramean army commander, who came back to thank prophet Elisha for healing him from his skin disease. Similarly, when Jesus healed ten lepers only one of them, a Samaritan, returned to thank Jesus and give glory to God. This Thanksgiving weekend, we are asked to reflect on our own lives to acknowledge and thank those who gifted us something. We can cultivate a spirit of thanksgiving and gratitude to God for the gift of life and all creation, our parents and our loved ones who have gifted us their love since many times we take their love for granted.
