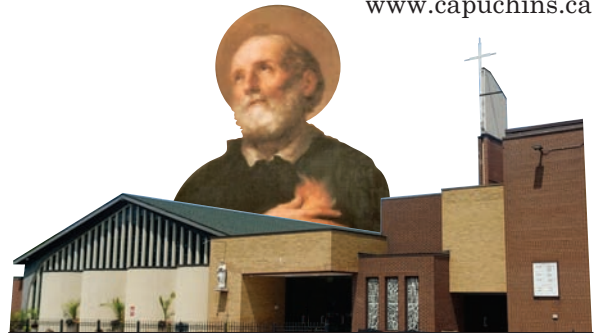

Weekly Reflection

Most of us may have had this experience, when we pray for something, but nothing seems to come of it. After some time, this can leave us disheartened and can cause us to question if God is really listening and can shake our faith in God. But Jesus, in this week's gospel, tells us to pray always and not to lose heart. Like the woman in the parable, we need to persevere in our prayer and not give up. We must always hold onto faith that God hears us and will answer our prayers according to God's will. God is a loving Father to all His children and wants to give us the best. But at times, that may not look like what we wanted. Like any loving parent, God will always give us what we need, not simply what we want. We must then not be discouraged when our prayers are not answered in the way we want them but rather continue to place our trust in our loving Father, who will always hear the prayers of his beloved children. So let us pray always and not lose heart.

La maggior parte di noi può aver avuto questa esperienza, quando preghiamo per qualcosa, ma sembra che non ne venga fuori nulla. Dopo un po' di tempo, questo può lasciarci scoraggiati e può farci dubitare che Dio stia davvero ascoltando e possa scuotere la nostra fede in Lui. Ma Gesù, nel vangelo di questa settimana, ci dice di pregare sempre e di non perderci d'animo. Come la donna della parabola, dobbiamo perseverare nella nostra preghiera e non arrenderci. Dobbiamo sempre tenerci stretti alla fede che Dio ci ascolta e risponderà alle nostre preghiere secondo la volontà di Dio. Dio è un Padre amorevole per tutti i Suoi figli e vuole darci il meglio. Ma a volte, potrebbe non sembrare quello che volevamo. Come ogni genitore amorevole, Dio ci darà sempre ciò di cui abbiamo bisogno, non semplicemente ciò che vogliamo. Non dobbiamo quindi scoraggiarci quando le nostre preghiere non vengono esaudite nel modo in cui vorremmo, ma piuttosto continuare a riporre la nostra fiducia nel nostro amorevole Padre, che ascolterà sempre le preghiere dei Suoi amati figli. Preghiamo dunque sempre e non perdiamoci d'animo.

La mayoría de nosotros puede haber tenido esta experiencia cuando oramos por algo, pero nada parece salir de ello. Después de un tiempo, esto puede dejarnos desanimados y puede hacernos dudar de que Dios realmente nos está escuchando y puede sacudir nuestra fe en Él. Pero Jesús, en el Evangelio de esta semana, nos dice que oremos siempre y que no nos desanimemos. Como la mujer de la parábola, debemos perseverar en nuestra oración y no rendirnos. Siempre debemos aferrarnos a la fe de que Dios nos escucha y responderá nuestras oraciones de acuerdo con la voluntad de Dios. Dios es un Padre amoroso para todos Sus hijos y quiere darnos lo mejor. Pero a veces, puede que no parezca lo que queríamos. Como cualquier padre amoroso, Dios siempre nos dará lo que necesitamos, no simplemente lo que queremos. Por lo tanto, no debemos desanimarnos cuando nuestras oraciones no son respondidas de la manera que nos gustaría, sino más bien continuar poniendo nuestra confianza en nuestro Padre amoroso, quien siempre escuchará las oraciones de sus amados hijos. Por lo tanto, oremos siempre y no desfallezcamos.

Parents/Guardians of children in grades 2-6 (for First Holy Communion) or children in grades 7-8 (for Confirmation) are required to attend only one of the information sessions.
