### Weekly Reflection

The theme of the readings for the commemoration of all the departed: Life is eternal. The Kingdom of Jesus Christ is divided into three parts: The Church Triumphant, the Church Militant, and the Suffering Church (CCC 954). The Church Triumphant is composed of those souls who live in the presence of God in the heavenly Sanctuary. The Church Militant, also called the "Pilgrim Church," are those of us who continue the fight against Satan's powers in this world. The Purgative Church has those souls judged worthy of salvation, but who must endure purification before entering the Beatific Vision. On November 2, we are asked to remember all the souls of the faithful departed who have passed away, and who suffer in Purgatory.

La Chiesa Militante, chiamata anche "Chiesa Pellegrina", sono quelli di noi che continuano la lotta contro i poteri di Satana in questo mondo. La Chiesa Purgativa ha quelle anime giudicate degne di salvezza, ma che devono sopportare la purificazione prima di entrare nella Visione Beatifica. Il 2 novembre ci viene chiesto di ricordare tutte le anime dei fedeli defunti che sono venuti a mancare e che soffrono in Purgatorio.

El tema de las lecturas para la conmemoración de todos los difuntos: La vida es eterna. El Reino de Jesucristo se divide en tres partes: La Iglesia Triunfante, la Iglesia Militante y la Iglesia Sufriente (CIC 954). La Iglesia Triunfante está compuesta por aquellas almas que viven en la presencia de Dios en el Santuario celestial. La Iglesia Militante, también llamada la "Iglesia Peregrina", somos aquellos de nosotros que continuamos la lucha contra los poderes de Satanás en este mundo. La Iglesia Purgante tiene aquellas almas juzgadas dignas de salvación, pero que deben soportar la purificación antes de entrar en la Visión Beatífica. El 2 de noviembre, se nos pide que recordemos a todas las almas de los fieles difuntos que se han ido, y que sufren en el Purgatorio.
