Weekly Reflection

A ritual to recognize God's glory and honor is to "dedicate" a place to him. Destroyed several times over the centuries, the basilica of St. John Lateran was always rebuilt, and its last reconsecration took place in 1724. On that occasion the feast we celebrate today was established and extended to the whole of Christendom. Now, it is interesting that precisely for this feast the Church chooses to proclaim liturgically the passage of the "purification of the temple" by Jesus. A gesture accompanied in the Gospel of John by these words: "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up"... He spoke of the temple of his body." Here is the great revelation: henceforth the dwelling place of God is no longer in the temple of Jerusalem – nor in any other "sacred" place – but the body of Jesus is the true dwelling place of God. The place where all humans can encounter God is Jesus, a man, a human flesh who is also the Word of God, the Son of God himself. Thanks to post-Easter faith we can confess that the dead and risen Christ is the eschatological temple, the place of encounter, covenant and communion between God and us!

Un rito per riconoscere a Dio gloria e onore è "dedicargli" un luogo. Più volte distrutta durante il corso dei secoli, la basilica di San Giovanni in Laterano fu sempre ricostruita, e l'ultima sua riconsacrazione avvenne nel 1724. In quell'occasione venne stabilita ed estesa a tutta la cristianità la festa che oggi celebriamo. Ora, è interessante che proprio per questa festa la Chiesa scelga di proclamare liturgicamente il brano della "purificazione del tempio" da parte di Gesù. Gesto accompagnato nel Vangelo di Giovanni da queste parole: «"Distruggete questo tempio e in tre giorni lo farò risorgere"... Egli parlava del tempio del suo corpo». Ecco la grande rivelazione: ormai la dimora di Dio non si trova più nel tempio di Gerusalemme – né in alcun altro luogo "sacro" –, ma il corpo di Gesù è la vera dimora di Dio. Il luogo dove tutti gli umani possono incontrare Dio è Gesù, un uomo, una carne umana che è anche la Parola di Dio, il Figlio stesso di Dio. Grazie alla fede post-pasquale possiamo confessare che il Cristo morto e risorto è il tempio escatologico, il luogo di incontro, alleanza e comunione tra Dio e noi!

Un ritual para reconocer la gloria y el honor de Dios es "dedicarle" un lugar. Destruída varias veces a lo largo de los siglos, la basilica de San Juan de Letrán siempre fue reconstruida, y su última riconsagración tuvo lugar en 1724. En esa ocasión se estableció la fiesta que celebramos hoy y se extendió a toda la cristiandad. Ahora bien, es interesante que precisamente para esta fiesta la Iglesia elija proclamar litúrgicamente el paso de la "purificación del templo" por Jesús. Un gesto acompañado en el Evangelio de Juan por estas palabras: "Destruíd este templo, y en tres días lo levantaré"... Habló del templo de su cuerpo". Aquí está la gran revelación: de ahora en adelante la morada de Dios ya no está en el templo de Jerusalén -ni en ningún otro lugar "sagrado"-, sino que el cuerpo de Jesús es la verdadera morada de Dios. El lugar donde todos los seres humanos pueden encontrar a Dios es Jesús, un hombre, una carne humana que es también la Palabra de Dios, el Hijo de Dios mismo. Gracias a la fe post-pascual podemos confesar que Cristo muerto y resucitado es el templo escatológico, el lugar de encuentro, alianza y comunión entre Dios y nosotros.
