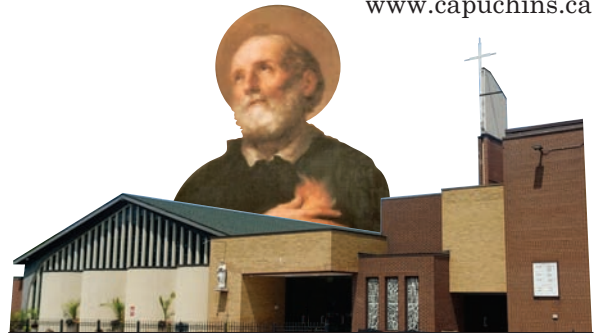

Weekly Reflection

The readings of the penultimate Sunday in Ordinary Time are eschatological as they speak about end times. Prophet Malachi refers to "the great day of the Lord" where divine punishment will fall on the wicked and divine restoration on the righteous, which in the Catholic understanding is the ushering of God's kingdom through "the coming of the Son of Man", Jesus Christ. In chapter twenty-one of Luke's gospel, Jesus foretells the destruction of Jerusalem, the Temple and the signs that precede them, but he warns about false prophets of doom. As we await Jesus' second coming in power and glory, we are asked to pray, to work, to not be idle, and to patiently endure till the end to "gain our souls".

Le letture della penultima domenica del Tempo Ordinario sono escatologiche in quanto parlano della fine dei tempi. Il profeta Malachia si riferisce al "grande giorno del Signore" in cui la punizione divina cadrà sui malvagi e la restaurazione divina sui giusti, che nella comprensione cattolica è l'introduzione del regno di Dio attraverso "la venuta del Figlio dell'uomo", Gesù Cristo. Nel capitolo ventuno del vangelo di Luca, Gesù predice la distruzione di Gerusalemme, del Tempio e dei segni che li precedono, ma mette in guardia contro i falsi profeti di sventura. Mentre attendiamo la seconda venuta di Gesù in potenza e gloria, ci viene chiesto di pregare, di lavorare, di non essere oziosi e di perseverare pazientemente fino alla fine per "guadagnare le nostre anime".

Las lecturas del penúltimo domingo del Tiempo Ordinario son escatológicas, ya que hablan del fin de los tiempos. El Profeta Malaquías se refiere al "gran día del Señor" donde el castigo divino caerá sobre los malvados y la restauración divina sobre los justos, que en el entendimiento católico es el comienzo del reino de Dios a través de "la venida del Hijo del Hombre", Jesucristo. En el capítulo veintiuno del evangelio de Lucas, Jesús predice la destrucción de Jerusalén, el Templo y las señales que los preceden, pero advierte sobre los falsos profetas de la fatalidad. Mientras esperamos la segunda venida de Jesús en poder y gloria, se nos pide que oremos, trabajemos, no estemos ociosos y perseveremos pacientemente hasta el final para "ganar nuestras almas".
