### Weekly reflection

In 1928, a saint was martyred for refusing to renounce his faith. Despite all the hardships he endured, even offering his life, he never gave up his faith. His name was St. Jose Sanchez del Rio, and what made him more admirable was that he was only 14 years old, and his last words before he died were "¡Viva Cristo Rey!" (Long Live Christ the King). This Sunday is the solemnity of Christ the King, and what does it mean to call Christ our King? St. Jose Sanchez shows us the answer. If we are to call Christ our King, then our lives must reflect that. We must live according to his laws and commandments, even when it may make us unpopular with those around us, or when it means we will be judged, mocked, or misunderstood. But why would we be afraid of that? Our King died on the cross and was judged, mocked, and misunderstood; yet he never backed away from proclaiming the truth. We must then follow confidently where our king has tread and has courage when we face challenges, whether from the culture or those around us. Let us truly proclaim with our lives that Christ is our King, ¡Viva Cristo Rey! Long Live Christ the King!

Nel 1928, un santo fu martirizzato per aver rifiutato di rinunciare alla sua fede. Nonostante tutte le difficoltà che aveva affrontato, offrendo persino la sua vita, non ha mai rinunciato alla fede. Si chiamava San José Sánchez del Río, e ciò che lo rendeva ancora più ammirevole era che aveva solo 14 anni, e le sue ultime parole prima di morire furono "¡Viva Cristo Rey!" (Viva Cristo Re). Questa domenica è la solennità di Cristo Re, e cosa significa chiamare Cristo nostro Re? St. Jose Sanchez ci mostra la risposta. Se dobbiamo chiamare Cristo nostro Re, allora le nostre vite devono riflettere questo. Dobbiamo vivere secondo le sue leggi e i suoi comandamenti, anche quando questo può renderci impopolari tra chi ci circonda, o quando significa che saremo giudicati, derisi o fraintesi. Ma perché dovremmo averne paura? Il nostro Re morì sulla croce e fu giudicato, deriso e frainteso; eppure non si tirò mai indietro dal proclamare la verità. Dobbiamo quindi seguire con sicurezza dove il nostro re ha calpestato e avere coraggio quando affrontiamo le sfide, sia dalla cultura che da chi ci sta intorno. Proclamiamo davvero con la nostra vita che Cristo è il nostro Re, ¡Viva Cristo Rey! Viva Cristo Re!

Debemos vivir según sus leyes y mandamientos, incluso cuando eso pueda hacernos impopulares entre quienes nos rodean, o cuando signifique que seremos juzgados, ridiculizados o malinterpretados. ¿Pero por qué deberíamos temerle? Nuestro Rey murió en la cruz y fue juzgado, ridiculizado e incomprendido; Sin embargo, nunca rehuyó proclamar la verdad. Por tanto, debemos seguir con confianza donde ha pisado nuestro rey y tener coraje ante los desafíos, tanto de la cultura como de quienes nos rodean. Proclamemos verdaderamente con nuestras vidas que Cristo es nuestro Rey, ¡Viva Cristo Rey!
