### Weekly Reflection

In today's Gospel, John doesn't simply introduce us to Jesus, but he does so by stepping aside: "After me comes a man who ranks before me, because he was before me." John knows he must diminish so that Jesus may increase; John doesn't lead to himself but to Jesus, he doesn't point to himself but to Jesus. It is the freedom of those who live not for themselves but for God, of those who don't possess but experience relationships as gifts. This is an important point, which requires vigilance and the exercise of inner freedom. We know well how important affections are, and how beautiful and important it is to experience healthy and real relationships in the Church, our family. However, there is a subtle danger of tying people to us, of bringing them to us and not toward the Truth, especially when it requires taking a step back or making corrections. We are all called to be like fingers pointing heavenward, pointing to the Love that has conquered our lives and enables us to make a gift of it.

Nel vangelo di oggi Giovanni non si limita a presentarci Gesù, ma lo fa facendosi da parte: «Dopo di me viene un uomo che è avanti a me, perché era prima di me». Giovanni sa di dover diminuire perché Gesù cresca; Giovanni non porta a sé ma a Gesù, non indica sé ma Gesù. È la libertà di chi non vive per sé ma per Dio, di chi non possiede ma vive le relazioni come dono. È un punto importante, che chiede vigilanza ed esercizio di libertà interiore. Sappiamo bene quanto siano importanti gli affetti, e quanto sia bello ed importante vivere relazioni sane e reali nella Chiesa, nostra famiglia. Tuttavia, è sottile il pericolo di legare a noi le persone, di portarle a noi e non verso la Verità, soprattutto quando richiede di fare un passo indietro o di correggere. Tutti noi siamo chiamati ad essere come delle dita puntate verso il cielo, e indicano quell'Amore che ha conquistato la nostra vita e ci rende capaci di farne un dono.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Juan no se limita a presentarnos a Jesús, sino que lo hace haciéndose a un lado: «Después de mí viene un hombre que me precede, porque ya existía antes que yo». Juan sabe que debe disminuir para que Jesús crezca; Juan no se dirige a sí mismo, sino a Jesús; no se señala a sí mismo, sino a Jesús. Es la libertad de quienes no viven para sí mismos, sino para Dios, de quienes no poseen, sino que viven las relaciones como dones. Este es un punto importante que requiere vigilancia y el ejercicio de la libertad interior. Sabemos bien lo importantes que son los afectos, y lo hermoso e importante que es vivir relaciones sanas y auténticas en la Iglesia, nuestra familia. Sin embargo, existe el sutil peligro de atar a las personas a nosotros mismos, de atraerlas hacia nosotros y no hacia la Verdad, especialmente cuando esto requiere dar un paso atrás o hacer correcciones. Todos estamos llamados a ser como dedos que apuntan al cielo, señalando el Amor que ha conquistado nuestras vidas y nos permite convertirlo en un don.
