Weekly Reflection

The lands of Zebulun and Naphtali were in the northern region of Galilee. After the Assyrian invasion, this region was known as the Galilee of the Gentiles due to a significant non-Jewish population. Isaiah prophesied that this region, which lived in darkness, would see a great light – a Messiah would bring salvation to all. Jesus fulfilled Isaiah's prophecy by starting his public ministry here. Jesus preached that as God's kingdom is near and has started to unfold, so people needed to turn their lives to God. The psalmist asks us to place our trust and confidence in the Lord, our light and salvation. Jesus' first disciples did so by immediately giving up everything and following Him. They were sent forth to bring others into God's kingdom.

Dopo l'invasione assira, questa regione era conosciuta come la Galilea dei Gentili a causa della significativa popolazione non ebraica. Isaia profetizzò che questa regione, che viveva nelle tenebre, avrebbe visto una grande luce: un Messia avrebbe portato la salvezza a tutti. Gesù adempì la profezia di Isaia iniziando qui il suo ministero pubblico. Gesù predicò che, poiché il regno di Dio è vicino e ha iniziato a manifestarsi, le persone devono volgere la propria vita a Dio. Il salmista ci chiede di riporre la nostra fiducia e la nostra confidenza nel Signore, nostra luce e salvezza. I primi discepoli di Gesù lo fecero abbandonando immediatamente tutto e seguendoLo. Furono mandati per condurre altri nel regno di Dio.

Jesús predicó que, como el reino de Dios está cerca y ha comenzado a manifestarse, las personas debían entregar sus vidas a Dios. El salmista nos pide que depositemos nuestra confianza en el Señor, nuestra luz y salvación. Los primeros discípulos de Jesús lo hicieron al dejarlo todo de inmediato y seguirlo. Fueron enviados a traer a otros al reino de Dios.
