

Weekly Reflection

God revealed His laws to His chosen people through Moses and the prophets in the Old Testament, and through His own Son, Jesus, in the New Testament. For the Israelites, the Torah was not a set of laws, but rather the instruction or teaching intended to promote the holiness and wholeness of each believer. In the Gospel, we see that Jesus did not come to abolish the law, but to reinterpret it and elevate it to another level. Jesus emphasizes that we must pay attention not only to what is done, but also to the why, or the inner motive, which only we and God know.

Dio rivelò le Sue leggi al Suo popolo eletto attraverso Mosè e i profeti nell'Antico Testamento, e attraverso Suo Figlio, Gesù, nel Nuovo Testamento. Per gli Israeliti, la Torah non era un insieme di leggi, ma piuttosto l'istruzione o l'insegnamento inteso a promuovere la santità e la completezza di ogni credente. Nel Vangelo, vediamo che Gesù non venne per abolire la legge, ma per reinterpretarla ed elevarla a un livello superiore. Gesù sottolinea che dobbiamo prestare attenzione non solo a ciò che viene effettivamente fatto, ma anche al perché, o al motivo interiore, che solo noi e Dio conosciamo.

Dios Reveló sus leyes a su Pueblo Elegido a través de Moisés y los profetas en el Antiguo Testamento, y a través de su propio hijo, Jesús, en el Nuevo Testamento. Para los israelitas, la Torá no era un conjunto de leyes, sino la instrucción o enseñanza destinada a promover la santidad y la plenitud de cada creyente. En el Evangelio, vemos que Jesús no vino a eliminar la ley, sino a reinterpretarla y elevarla a otro nivel. Jesús enfatiza que debemos prestar atención no solo lo que realmente se hace, sino también el porqué, o el motivo interno, que solo nosotros y Dios conoce.
