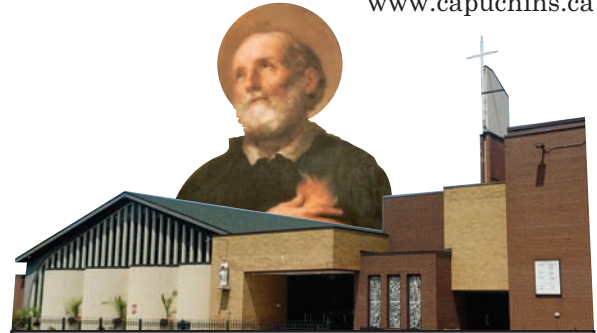

In today's gospel, Jesus was moved with compassion about the plight of the people whom he found as helpless and harassed sheep who were without a shepherd. Jesus saw that the harvest plentiful but with few labourers. Thus, as Lord of the harvest, Jesus sends his twelve apostles to gather in the people with a two-fold mission of proclaiming and healing. After every Eucharistic celebration, we, Christ's followers, are sent out into the world to speak the good news we heard and to heal and cure others through our words and actions. By this we will live out our vocation to be God's chosen people who are a priestly kingdom and a holy nation who serve others with, in, and through love.

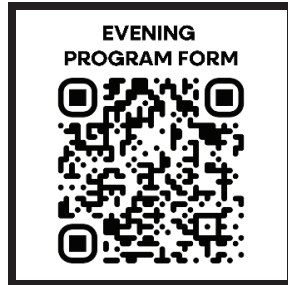
