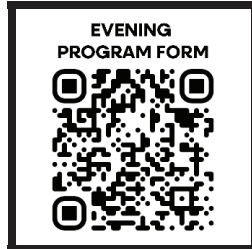

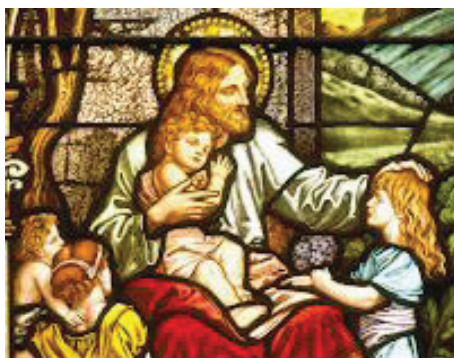


Bequest to your parish
