Weekly Reflection

In the Gospel reading for this 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus teaches that true Christian charity obliges Christians not only to help their neighbors in their temporal and spiritual needs with material assistance and prayer, but also to offer correction and counsel to a brother or sister who has harmed the community through public sin. If the wayward brother or sister rejects loving, individual correction from the offended party, then the Christian should try to involve more people to point out their errors: first, "one or two more," and finally, "the Church."

Nel Vangelo di questa 23^a domenica del Tempo Ordinario, Gesù insegna che la vera carità cristiana obbliga i cristiani non solo ad aiutare il prossimo nei suoi bisogni materiali e spirituali con assistenza materiale e preghiera, ma anche a offrire correzione e consiglio a un fratello o una sorella che ha recato danno alla comunità con un peccato pubblico. Se il fratello o la sorella che si è allontanato dalla retta via rifiuta la correzione amorevole e individuale da parte della persona offesa, allora il cristiano dovrebbe cercare di coinvolgere più persone per fargli notare i suoi errori: prima "una o due persone in più", e infine "la Chiesa".

En el Evangelio de este 23 domingo de tiempo ordinario. Jesús enseña que la verdadera caridad cristiana obliga al cristiano no solo a ayudar a sus prójimos en sus necesidades temporales y espirituales con ayuda material y oración, sino también con corrección y consejo para un hermano o hermana que ha dañado a la comunidad con su pecado público. Si el hermano errante rechaza una corrección amorosa individual por parte de la persona ofendida, entonces el cristiano debe intentar involucrar a más personas que vayan a decirle sus errores: primero, "una o dos más" y, finalmente, "la Iglesia".
