Weekly Reflection

This Sunday's Gospel presents us with something fundamental to human relationships: forgiveness. We all experience how difficult it is to forgive and how long the journey of healing can be. Forgiveness is a slow, progressive process that involves the whole person. Indeed, the act of forgiving is merely the final step in a long process of purification and healing. When we have been offended, feelings of resentment, anger, and a desire for revenge or for the offender's punishment immediately arise within us. We need time to regain the composure we may have lost. And here we must ask ourselves: "Do we desire to forgive?" For if someone declares from the outset, "I do not want to forgive!", there is little more to be said. It is a different matter when we say from the bottom of our hearts: "I want to forgive, but I cannot! Help me, Lord!" Those who say this open themselves to the work of the Holy Spirit and engage their will, their intellect, and their heart, seeking—with God's grace—to forgive sincerely. They understand that forgiving is not an act of weakness, but of strength. They understand that to hate is to live a hellish life. To succeed in forgiving is to set a prisoner free—and to discover that the prisoner was you!

Il Vangelo di questa domenica ci presenta ciò che è fondamentale nelle relazioni umane: perdonare. Tutti noi sperimentiamo quanto sia difficile perdonare e quanto è lungo un cammino di guarigione. Il perdono è un processo lento, progressivo, che coinvolge tutta la sfera della persona. Il gesto del perdono, infatti, è solo l'ultimo atto che riguarda un lungo processo di purificazione e di guarigione. Quando abbiamo ricevuto un'offesa, immediatamente scatta in noi il risentimento, la rabbia, il desiderio di vendetta o di punizione della persona che ci ha offeso. C'è bisogno di un po' di tempo perché riprendiamo il controllo che magari abbiamo perso. E qui c'è da chiedersi: "Abbiamo il desiderio di perdonare?", perché se uno a priori dice: "Non voglio perdonare!", c'è poco da dire! Diverso è quando diciamo di vero cuore: "Vorrei perdonare ma non ci riesco! Aiutami tu, Signore!". Ecco, chi dice ciò, si apre all'opera dello Spirito Santo e mette in gioco la sua volontà, la sua intelligenza, il suo cuore perché vuole giungere, con la grazia di Dio, a perdonare di vero cuore. Perché comprende che perdonare non è un atto di debolezza ma di forza. Perché comprende che odiare è vivere una vita d'inferno. Riuscire a perdonare è liberare un prigioniero e scoprire che quel prigioniero eri tu!

El Evangelio de este domingo nos presenta lo fundamental en las relaciones humanas: el perdón. Todos experimentamos lo difícil que es perdonar y lo largo que es el camino hacia la sanación. El perdón es un proceso lento y progresivo que involucra a la persona en su totalidad. De hecho, el acto de perdonar es solo el último paso en un largo proceso de purificación y sanación. Cuando nos sentimos ofendidos, el resentimiento, la ira y el deseo de venganza o castigo hacia quien nos ofendió surgen inmediatamente en nosotros. Nos lleva tiempo recuperar el control que pudimos haber perdido. Y aquí debemos preguntarnos: "¿Tenemos el deseo de perdonar?". Porque si alguien dice a priori: "¡No quiero perdonar!", ¡poco hay que decir! Es diferente cuando decimos de corazón: "¡Quisiera perdonar, pero no puedo! ¡Ayúdame, Señor!". Ahora bien, quien dice esto se abre a la obra del Espíritu Santo y compromete su voluntad, su inteligencia, su corazón porque quiere, con la gracia de Dios, perdonar de corazón. Porque comprende que perdonar no es un acto de debilidad, sino de fortaleza. Porque comprende que odiar es vivir un infierno. Ser capaz de perdonar es liberar a un prisionero y descubrir que ese prisionero eras tú mismo.
