Weekly Reflection

This Sunday's readings inform us that God's ways far exceed human ways. Jesus explains, by a parable, that God's infinite love and compassion cannot be fully grasped by mortal minds. God wants humans to live and thrive in the world. If this is attained by working, then God ensures that humans will get work to provide for their families. God looks at human needs and gives generously in his love. As we come to the vineyard of faith at different times in our lives, let us appreciate each other's gifts since God gives us the fullness of life as he deems right and just. Thus, open our hearts to receive God's bountiful love and goodness as he gives all of himself to us.
